Spring Representative Assembly Minutes
June 11, 2020**

President Karen Lloyd – Indian Creek, called the meeting to order at 5:06 PM. The meeting was held virtually via Zoom.

Sondra Vojvodich – Indian Creek, moved to adopt the agenda with flexibility, second Robin Schoene – Bellaire. Motion carried.

Jamie Thompson – Steubenville, moved the proposed budget on behalf of the Board of Directors. Motion carried.

The “new” positions created by the Constitutional change will also be referred to the Board of Directors. The Muskingum C position will be for one year in order to accommodate the rotation of elections.
